


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J&L Oil Separator, Passenger Side (2021.5-2024 Ford Ranger 2.3L EcoBoost) #3037D

Installation Instructions




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Route hose with male fitting in between battery and rubber hose. Make connection to the factory line you removed earlier.

Route hose with 90 degree fitting between EVAP hardline and rubber hose with wireloom. See picture below. Make connection to intake manifold.



Note: The fitting in the J&L Hose has a push button release, along with a locking tab. See below for how this fitting operates. The locking tab can only be engaged once installed onto connection.



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To remove:



Tab Unlocked, Button pressed to release

TIP: The quick connections are all adjustable in the end of the hoses, if the fitting isn't at an optimum angle, twist the fitting until it is. The hoses can also twist on the J&L Oil separator connections for adjustment, use the natural bend of the hoses to your advantage.

Mount J&L Oil Separator and bracket to the valve cover with supplied bolt. Do not completely tighten the bolt yet. If equipped with factory engine cover, install over cover stud and reinstall nut.




Route J&L hose with the male fitting from the factory line under hard breather line at the front of the engine towards the radiator. You will need to trim this hose to fit, typical trim is 6" off the end of the hose.

Connect the above hose to the "C" side of the oil separator. Be sure to grease or oil inside of hose for lubrication, this will aide you in sliding the hose all the way onto the fitting. Install the provided dress up end on the end of the hose before installing onto the oil separator.

Route J&L hose from the intake manifold OVER the hard breather line at the front of the engine, this will ensure the line can't ever fall into the radiator fan. Connect the hose to the "O" side of the oil separator. See picture below.

Once complete, tighten 10mm bolt to secure bracket to valve cover.

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Check oil separator after 1000 miles of driving to assess how much contaminates your engine is putting through the PCV system.

To properly clean the filter in the Oil Separator, spray any degreaser or solvent through it and let it air dry. Clean it every 10,000 miles.
